New acquisitions/investments in 2019

Besides new school furniture for our new classes (about 30.000 Euro) we bought LEGO-WeDo 2.o, Sphero Minis (coding with mini robots) and a Stabilo pen for our classes, all together for around 3.000 Euro. In our secondary school, the new multifunctional room has been completed (10.000 Euro) and we are in the process of choosing the right furniture (about 15.000 Euro). The room will be used from the new school year for several functions such as breaks, group work, project work or simply to relax.



School transport/school bus

Due to the great interest in our school bus, which is already occupied with 8 places, we are trying to organise two more school buses with an additional 16 places in total. The trips are expected to start or end at the main train station. All parents registered for the school bus will receive more information before the summer holidays.

Summer camp until school enrolment

Together with our cooperation partner Hannover 96, we have tried to organise a so-called "bridging camp" for all new Year 1 students in the period from 1st August until the start of school. Unfortunately, Hannover 96 was unable to make us an offer for this year, as the trainers themselves are on holiday during this time.

Development of German in the primary school

Next school year, we will adjust the primary school curriculum so that all classes get seven German lessons per week, which means one more lesson per week per class. The ethics lessons in Year 3 and 4 will also be taught in German again to increase the proportion of the teaching language German. In addition, we will expand our German curriculum in the course of the next school year with relation to the core competences. In the other subjects we have already introduced this by integrating worldwide, international competences from other curricula, now it is the turn of the subject German. This means that our competencies will also be more strongly oriented towards the UK curriculum and that we will be able to offer our children a broader learning spectrum than the curriculum in Germany prescribes. In addition, we will analyse the handwriting of the students with the help of the Stabilo pen in order to be able to formulate more precise diagnoses and individual handwriting goals - more on this in our next newsletter!

Primary Summer Shows

We have included an additional performance of the summer show in our schedule to give more visitors the opportunity to see the show. The performances will now take place on Thursday, 27th June and Friday, 28th June at 2:30pm in the Mensa. All students need to be brought back to their classrooms after their lunch break before we open our school gates to visitors. For this reason, admission does not begin until 2:10pm. In order to be able to distribute all guests over the two performance days, we ask you to get a stamped admission ticket (free of charge) from either school office (after the Whitsun holidays). Blue tickets are valid for Thursday, red tickets for Friday. We are providing 200 tickets for each of the days.
