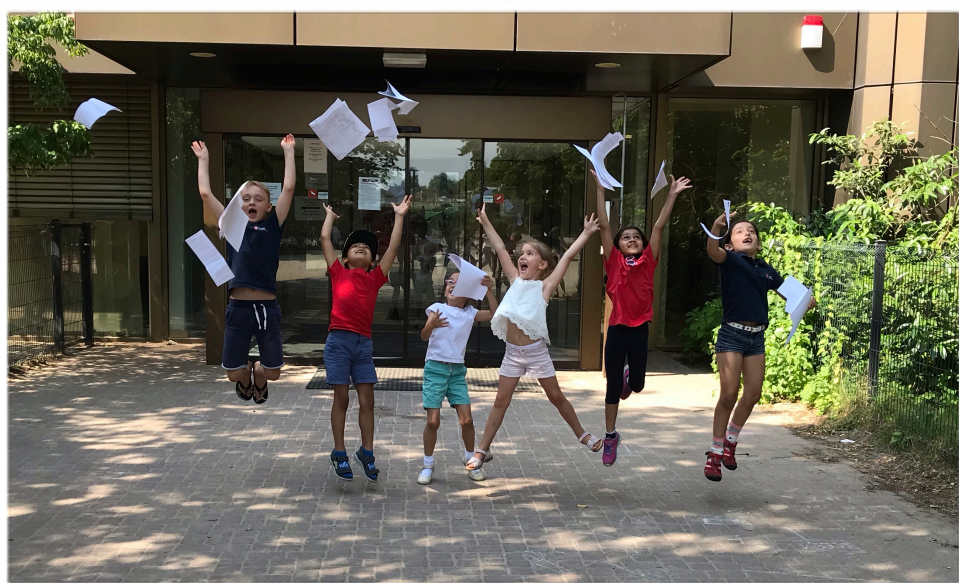

## Secondary

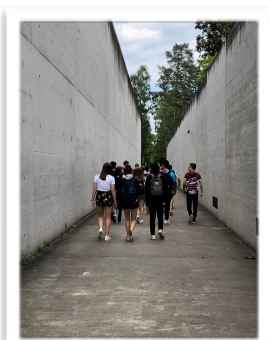
