Important information for parents of school children:

1) Face masks

Please make sure that your child has more than one mouth-nose cover in their school bag. Since the beginning of the school year, we have distributed over 50 face masks to replace dirty and broken masks. From now on, we will have to charge you 1 Euro when your child receives a new face mask from us.

2) Breaks

The students have settled in very well and now know their year group areas in the schoolyard. We would now like to slowly move on to a mask-free break time on the schoolyard - but we need your support for this. For practical reasons, we need a hygienic solution for storing the face masks - it is mandatory to still wear a mask in the corridors and the school building.

Please give your child a freezer bag with a ZIP lock/zipper. Please write your child's name and class on the bag (see photo). Your child can take this bag to the playground and store the mask in it during the break. It is important that your child can keep the bag in a trouser or jacket pocket.



If your child is not bringing in a plastic bag; the face mask will still need to be worn outside as well.

3) Whilst the majority of you have been diligent with following our hygiene rules, a small minority has now started to relax about the rules with regards to wearing the face mask on the school car park and grounds. This is unacceptable and we urge you to comply with these rules to help us fulfil our duty of care to all members of the KIBS families and their relatives. Please remember to leave the school grounds immediately after picking up your child, the playground is currently not to be used outside of school hours.
